TIMBER SALE AGREEMENT

I, _____, Illinois Timber Buyer License Number

_____, hereinafter called the purchaser, agree to purchase from the Rock Island County Forest Preserve Commission of Rock Island, Illinois, hereinafter called the seller, the designated trees from the area described as follows:

The area is located in Rock Island County, Port Byron Township (T19N; R1E), Sections 24 & 25.

Trees have been designated for cutting with red/orange paint marks both on the stump at ground line, and on the bole at shoulder height.

CONDITIONS OF THE SALE:

1. The Purchaser agrees to harvest the marked timber and pay the Seller a fixed or flat fee of \$ _____ for logs marked for harvest. The 4% Harvest fee, payable to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IL DNR), will be deducted from the Seller's fee and shall be forwarded to the IL DNR by the Purchaser. The Purchaser agrees to provide the Seller with proof of the purchase price of the timber sold.
2. Restrictions to cutting- It is the intent of the Seller to have this timber harvest occur in the winter months, during frozen ground conditions, to help minimize the impact on the forest. Winter is also a time of low recreational activity at the forest preserves. The Purchaser agrees to this restriction and will consult with the Park Ranger on timing his cutting operations.
3. The Purchaser agrees to repair damage caused by logging to ditches, fences, bridges, roads, trails or buildings. All roads, streams and fields shall be left clear and free from logs and treetops. All tree tops from felled trees shall be broken down to within four (4) feet of the ground.
4. Purchaser hereby agrees to provide Proof of Insurance to the Seller and further agrees that any and all liability for injury or damage suffered or sustained by any person or to anyone's property caused in any way arising out the Purchaser's performance of this contract shall be a risk assumed and borne by the Purchaser. The Purchaser agrees to name the Rock Island County Forest Preserve District as an additional insured. The Purchaser hereby further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the sellers from any such liability.
5. The Seller agrees to guarantee title to the designated timber covered by this agreement and to defend it against all claims at his/her expense.
6. The Seller agrees to allow ingress and egress at all reasonable times unless specified in writing that restriction exist due to weather, road conditions or crops.
7. The Purchaser agrees to make every effort not to damage young trees, particularly trees designated as crop trees. Seller may be compensated for damage which is deemed excessive, by a third party, and for wrongfully cut trees.

8. This agreement shall not be assigned in whole or in part without the written consent of the Seller.
9. All modifications of this agreement will be reduced in writing, dated, signed and witnessed on the back of this agreement.
10. This Agreement shall expire on April 1, 2015.

Having read this agreement, the Seller and the Purchaser accept the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement and indicate such with their signature below:
